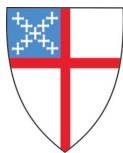

Another successful rummage sale!

Thanks to a lot of hard work by a cadre of dedicated workers, the rummage sale did a brisk business over its ten-day run, and netted \$806 for the Guild, which pledges \$3,000 annually for the upkeep of the church buildings and grounds. The money helps pay for mowing, snow removal, and repairs for the church and rectory.



Donated goods continued to come in almost every day of the sale, and although business was brisk, there were still the inevitable sale "leftovers." As was true after last fall's sale, the unsold items were picked up by We Care in Dodgeville for distribution to the needy.
